

HBHC Meeting Minutes April 25, 2011

Meeting called to order by Lisa at 7:12pm. In attendance: Diana, Jennifer, Lisa, Melissa, Gwen, Region 13 guest Meredith.

Minutes from the March meeting held on March 28, 2011 were read. Motion by Jennifer, second by Gwen to approve the minutes. Motion passed.

Treasurer's Report by Gwen:

Motion by Diana, second by Jennifer to approve the Treasurer's Report. Motion passed.

Bills: Jennifer submitted bills for awards for \$263.07; Francine submitted bills for copies, class cards and plastic covers for \$67.87; and Heather submitted a bill for insurance for \$75. Motion by Diana, second by Melissa to pay the bills. Motion passed.

Old Business:

1. May Show: The judge asked for a list of available equipment so that she can make up the trail pattern. Jennifer already sent a list of available trail equipment to Melissa, who forwarded it to the judge. We need flyers posted. The entry is on the web and has been emailed. Melissa hopes to have pattern copies ahead of time but can make copies at home the day of the show if necessary. We still need an announcer; Lisa will contact Marianne Larkin to see if she is available. Jennifer will make award tickets and add the year to the tickets. Awards are ordered. We are not sure if the judge will bring a ring steward, Diana will be the gate person.
2. Fair Show: Lisa clarified with Redwood Acres that only open classes cost \$10 to enter and will receive premiums. The old 2010 entry is still online but Jennifer talked to them about getting a CORRECTED copy of the 2011 entry online.
3. Schooling Show: There was a small turn out but lots of opportunity to ride but we picked up 3 memberships and covered expenses.
4. Cuneo Creek: Lisa put up flyers around town.

New Business:

1. HBHC hats: Lisa checked with Solo Sports and hats would cost \$12 with the letters HBHC embroidered on them. We could sell them for \$15 or \$20 at Cuneo or the shows. Lisa will order 12 of them.

2. Arena at Redwood Acres: Discussion about the current footing. Lisa will check on whether it is being worked or not.

3. California Senate Bill SB 697 was discussed. If passed this bill would require that equine chiropractors, dentists, message therapists, etc be licensed DVMs. It is in the process of coming up for a vote in the near future.
